INTERNAL REGULATION

General Conditions

1°) Membership Conditions

To be allowed to enter, to settle down and to stay on a plot, you need to have authorization from the camp manager or his representative. You have to look after the maintenance and the tidiness of the plot as well as comply with this internal regulation.

Staying on the camp implies the acceptance of its rules and the promise to comply with them.

2°) Formalities of entry

Anyone who stays at least one night in the camps has to present his ID to the manager or his representative and complete the form required by the police.

3°) Settling in

The tent or the caravan and its equipment have to be sited on the indicated place according to the manager's directives.

4°) Reception and Technical Service

Low season from 01 April to 30th June and from 1st September to 16th September.

→ Open from 9AM to 12PM and from 2PM to 7PM, seven days a week

High season (July and August)

→ Open from 8AM to 9PM, seven days a week

Closure Rental Season from 16th September to 31st March

→ Open from 9AM to 12PM and from 2PM to 6PM, closed at week ends

Closure Resident park from 1st November to 28th February.

At reception you will find information about camp services, grocery possibilities, sport facilities, tourist attractions in the vicinity and various useful addresses.

5°) Entrance gate

The entrance gate is locked from 11PM to 7AM. In case of emergency, there is an intercom on the reception wall. (During the park closure time, the gate remains locked)

6°) Access card

The magnetic card is for only one vehicle. It cannot be used by another user or else it will stop functioning.

7°) Fees

The fees are paid at the reception. The amount is on the notice board at the camp entrance and at reception. They are owed according to the number of nights spent in the campsite.

Campsite users are asked to inform reception of their departure a day before.

Campers who plan to leave before the opening hours of reception must pay the day before their departure.

8°) Noise and silence

Campsite users must avoid all noise and discussions which could annoy their neighbours. Audio devices have to be set up accordingly. Please, be considerate to your immediate neighbours and respect children sleeping, by day and by night.

When you close your car doors and boot, try to be as quiet as possible.

Dogs and other pets must never be left free. They mustn't be left alone at the campsite, even locked in, when the owner is not there as he is legally responsible. For the camping and seasonal rental, pets are not allowed in July and August.

THERE SHOULD BE COMPLETE SILENCE BETWEEN 00.00 H AND 7AM.

9°) Visitors

After being allowed by the camp manager, visitors can enter the camp under the responsibility of the inviting campers.

Campers can receive visitors at the reception. If these visitors are allowed to enter, the camper who invites them has to pay an additional fee, so that the visitor can access the campsite facilities.

The amount of the fee is displayed on the notice board at the entrance and at reception.

Visitors' cars are forbidden in the campsite.

10°) Traffic and car parking

Inside the campsite, cars must not exceed the speed limit, 10 km/h.

Traffic is forbidden between 11PM and 7AM.

Only vehicles owned by the campers are allowed inside the campsite.

Parking of only one car per site is permitted; and is completely forbidden on vacant plots.

Vehicles should not disturb the traffic and the settling in of newcomers.

11°) Maintenance and appearance of the facilities

No one should do anything to spoil the cleanliness, hygiene and appearance of the campsite facilities. Campsite users must dispose of their waste water in the dedicated areas.

It is forbidden to dispose of waste water on the ground or in trenches.

Rubbish must be put in the rubbish bins at the “local poubelle”. Recycling containers are also available.

No one should do anything to spoil the cleanliness, hygiene and appearance of the campsite bathrooms. The bathrooms must always be left clean and functional by the users. Washing and dish washing is strictly forbidden outside dedicated areas and sinks.

You should not hang up washing on the trees.

Plantations and flowers must be respected. It is strictly forbidden to put nails in the trees, cut branches or plant flowers without an authorization from the camp manager.

It is not allowed to create a site for a facility or dig the ground.

Any damage to vegetation, fences, plots or the facilities of the camp will be charged to the one who causes it.

The plot which is used during the stay must be given back in the same state as the camper found it upon his arrival.

Moreover it is strictly forbidden to:

- build fences
- stock waste objects
- add wooden, steel or other-material sheds
- remove mobility means – wheels, tow bar, etc – from the caravans, whatever their size
- build canopy, terraces or garden sheds
- put up movable or dismountable houses, without a regulation authorization
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The maximum area used by the equipment on the site should not exceed 30 per cent of the area of the plot.

12°) Safety

Fire:

Open fires and BBQs (wood, coal, etc...) are strictly forbidden. Gas barbecues must be in a good state and should be used with care.

In case of fire, IMMEDIATELY inform the Management.

You can use extinguishers if necessary.

There is a medical kit for emergencies at reception.

Theft:

Management is responsible for objects left at the office and has a general obligation to watch the campsite.

Campers are responsible of their own equipment and must inform management of the presence or behaviour of any suspect person.

Although the camp is guarded, camp users should take the usual precautions to protect their equipment.

13°) Games

Any violent or annoying games are forbidden close to the facilities.
Rooms cannot be used for rough or noisy games.
Children must be kept under their parents' supervision.

14°) Unused parking

Unused equipment can be left on a site only after management's agreement and at the indicated location.
Parking of any added vehicle will be charged 5 Euros a day.
Parking of any trailer will be charged 5 Euros a day.

15°) Notice board

This internal regulation is displayed at the camps entrance and at reception.
The customer can request a copy.

16°) Offence to the internal regulation

If the customer disturbs other customers or does not respect the rules, Management will be able to order him, orally or in writing, to stop such behaviour.

In case of serious or repeated offences to the rules and after the manager's warning, he will be able to end the agreement.

In case of penal offence, Management can call the Police.
